NOTICE OF ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT PROCESS

The proponent, San Miguel Fruits SA (Pty) Ltd proposes to expand citrus production at their existing operations on Portion 7 of Farm 92 Tregaron, Sundays River Valley Municipal area (SRVA), also referred to as Sylvana, which measures approximately 243,82ha in extent. The proponent proposes to transform an area measuring approximately 115ha on the western section of the farm. Irrigation of the proposed agricultural development requires the construction of a new dam, with a capacity of approximately 30 000m³ (0.5ha footprint).

In terms of the NEMA EIA Regulations, 2014 (as amended), published in GN R326, 327, 325 and 324, promulgated under Chapter Five of the National Environmental Management Act (Act 107 of 1998), and published in Government Gazette 40772 on the 7 April 2017, the project requires full Scoping and Environmental Impact Assessment, as it includes, amongst others, the following listed activity in GN R325 (Listing Notice 2):

"15. The clearance of an area of 20 hectares or more of indigenous vegetation."
