You are required to submit any comments that you may have on the CBAR by the **3 June 2019**, to the Environmental Assessment Practitioner (EAP), contact details provided above.

#### **Next Step in the Process**

The next step in the Basic Assessment Process entails the inclusion of the comments made by I&APs during the current comment period, into the Final Basic Assessment Report (FBAR), prior to it being submitted to the competent authority (Department of Economic Development, Environmental Affairs and Tourism – Sarah Baartman Region) for their decision-making. No comment period is proposed for the FBAR. As a registered I&AP on the project database, you will be notified in writing of the submission of the FBAR to the competent authority.
