**RE: NOTICE OF AMENDMENT APPLICATION PROCESS: PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDED ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORISATION FOR THE EXPANSION OF AGRICULTURAL ACTIVITIES ON PORTIONS 9, 10 & 14 OF FARM KREMLIN NO. 100, FORMING PART OF THE FARM KNOWN AS INTSOMI, SUNDAYS RIVER VALLEY MUNICIPALITY**

In terms of the NEMA EIA Regulations, 2014 (as amended), published in GN R326, 327, 325 and 324, promulgated under Chapter Five of the National Environmental Management Act (as amended), you have been identified as an interested and/ or affected party (I&AP) for the above proposed project.

The proponent, JN Venter Family Trust, proposes to expand agricultural activities of Portion 9, 10 and 14 of Farm Kremlin No 100, known as Intsomi, in the Sundays River Valley Municipality, for the establishment of citrus orchards and associated infrastructure (internal irrigation pipes, internal roads). Since an existing Environmental Authorisation has been issued for Intsomi farm, the proposed agricultural expansion activities require that an Amendment Application Process be undertaken. Intsomi falls within the Sundays River Valley Municipal area (SRVM) and the closest boundary of Intsomi farm is located approximately 8.8 km east of the town of Enon and approximately 9km north of Sunland.

Public Process Consultants has been appointed as the independent Environmental Assessment Practitioner (EAP) to undertake the Amendment Application process for this project. In order to ensure that any issues and/ or concerns you may have, are included in the **Draft Amendment Report**, you are kindly requested to submit your comments to the Environmental Assessment Practitioner indicated above, during the comment period, which extends from the **15 September to 16 October 2020**.
